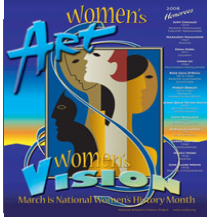

- Nominations should be type-written, follow the guidelines and questions, and may not exceed the space allotted.
- A one-page, single-sided, 12-point font narrative page may be attached to this form in lieu of this 3-paragraph answer format.
- Nomination must be **postmarked, or sent electronically to pbohm@dalycity.org, by THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2008.**
- **Nominees should plan on being available for the March 14, 2008 awards reception at the Daly City Women of Excellence Evening Reception at Daly City's City Hall & Rotunda/Octagon Gallery. The Reception fee is \$15 per person. *Please pre-register first.**

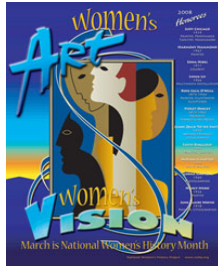
