Dr. Barry Rosen, M.D. is Medical Director of the Sequoia Center. He is on staff at San Mateo County General Hospital and is an attending physician at Stanford University Medical Center. During the three hour workshop Dr. Rosen will discuss the disease of addiction addressing detoxification and co-morbidity with psychiatric and pain conditions.

Objective: Improve interventions in treatment of addiction, addressing neurobiology distinct to addicts.

Goals: Participants will be able to describe and discuss in the context of the Bio/Psycho/Social/Spiritual model of addiction.

1. Neurobiology of addiction
2. Neurobiological changes caused by amphetamines and methamphetamines
3. Successful approaches in the interaction with and treatment for addicts

We will address the specific abuse of alcohol, amphetamines and pain medications. We will also address interviewing and treating difficult patients. There will a grand rounds style of specific case presentations. Dr. Rosen will present the morning session from 9:00 am to noon.
