Free Pediatric Checkups and Immunizations

Full physical checkups for children 18 and younger. Medical providers will provide back-to-school checkups, immunizations, health education, sports physicals, vision screenings, dental screenings, safety tips, nutrition advice and more. Please bring any immunization records and any medications currently being taken.

Free Women's Health Screenings

Receive a full physical exam, including Pap smears, sexually transmitted disease testing, clinical breast exams, birth control options and health education.

Sign Up for No and Low Cost Insurance

Get insured! Sign up for San Mateo County's no/low-cost insurance plans available to children. Your immigration status does not matter. Please bring with you the following documents to see if your children qualify:

- Proof of San Mateo County residency (utility bill, rental agreement, or driver's license)
- Proof of income (recent pay stub, 2006 federal tax return, or letter from charitable organization)
- Proof of your child's age (birth or baptism certificate, or child's social security card)
