Essay requirements:

- 12-point font, double-spaced, typed.
- Minimum 250 words, maximum 500 words.
- **Name, phone number, and e-mail address on the top right of each page.**



## **Essay Evaluation Criteria**

Essays will be submitted to the Jobs for Youth Committee for review. The Committee will evaluate scholarship essays based on the following criteria:

- A clear vocational or educational focus
- Accomplishments
- Hardships faced
- Need for financial assistance
- Planned use of scholarship
